According to Section 3.2 of the Suice and Regulations, the eligibility criteria for participating in a PCNC team are as follows.

- (a) An individual must satisfy one of the following conditions:
  - must be a permanent employee or an Affiliated. Company Social-Severnment Organization, or NGO
  - (iii) must be the spouse of a permanent employee, propleyed by an Affiliated Company Septi-Severment Organization or MSC) or
  - (iii) must be the single daughter of a permanent an ployage in proyect by an Affiliated Company, Somi-Government Organization, nr NGC, et and time of registration.
